## 27th Annual Invitational Golf Outing Scheduled

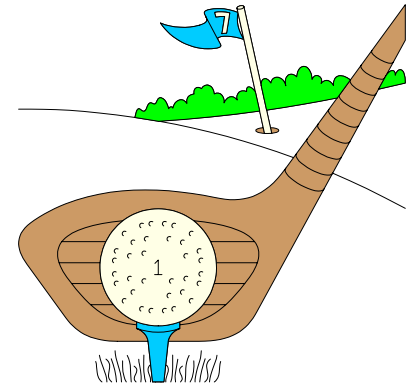

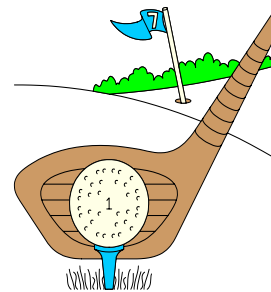
